


We asked people questions about the NDIS like.






126 people told us about things like.




- information is hard.






Treasury White Paper

- • inclusive workplaces.





Our Voice SA talked to the Treasury Department about jobs for people with intellectual disability.

- Our ideas to make jobs better for people with intellectual disability.






Lots of OVSA members went to the SACID
Leading Through Inclusion conference.





Place a cup on the floor with 4 dice inside. Drop a ball into the cup from eye height.


The ball must stay in the cup.






